Point Option History

Point Option began in 1973 as a Title 111(IVC) grant program in Newport News, Virginia and continues to be a voluntary high school program of choice requiring an application process.

Point Option moved to New Horizons in August 1995 in an attempt to become a regional program; however, the high school program is now limited to the residents of Newport News.

The program has had four homes during its 30 year existence and recently moved into a new facility centrally located off of J. Clyde Morris Blvd. & Diligence Drive to provide better access to all of the NNPS comprehensive high schools.

Detailed evaluations were conducted by the local system and the state auditors during the early years of the program. School Improvement Objectives have been the basis for more recent evaluations.

Students best served by the program are generally high ability, underachieving high school youth.

Data kept during the lifetime of the school indicate positive increases in attendance, achievement and attitude.

Parent surveys indicate positive results in their responses to statements about their student's attitudes and achievement.

NNPS provides transportation to and from Point Option from students' zoned schools.

Graduates and participants continue to maintain ties to the school. Graduates include persons from all walks of life including; lawyers, police, contractors, computer specialist and sales persons.

Who Attends Point Option?

The Point Option student possesses average to above average academic ability but has not been successful in their home/zoned school environment.

- ⇒ Students with high SOL scores & low grades.
- ⇒ Students with high SOL scores and poor attendance.
- ⇒ Capable students who could benefit from a small pupil-to-teacher ratio and can work independently.
- ⇒ Capable students who can increase their course load through a combination of inhouse distance & classroom learning.
- ⇒ Capable students who can "recover failed credits" through in-house distance learning.
- ⇒ Capable senior students who could complete high school in one semester through classroom &/or on-site distance learning.
- ⇒ Capable senior students who need flexible schedules due to personal issues.

Admission Process:

Admission to Point Option is voluntary and requires an official application. Students will be selected based on these factors:

- the capability to be academically successful
- appropriate school and social behavior
