

## The POINT OPTION

### ...STUDENT

possesses *average to above average academic ability* but has not been successful in their home/zoned school environment.

### ...APPLICATION

is required of all students interested in attending Point Option. All students interested in attending Point Option must be a second semester freshmen or older. Point Option does not accept first-time 9<sup>th</sup> grade students. **All interested students must complete and submit an application** (found under “Families”) **via fax, mail or in person.** Upon reviewing the application, the staff of Point Option will schedule an interview with the prospective student and their parent/guardian. **Acceptance is not guaranteed as the program is limited to 90 students at any given time.**

### ...VOLUNTARY PROGRAM

*requires that all students who attend must remain in good standing academically and socially or their membership in the program will be terminated.*

### ...SUCCESS STORY

has spanned thirty plus years. **This year, the first in our new Denbigh location, Point Option experienced a 70% increase in graduation rates from the 2007/08 school year.**



### WHO ATTENDS?

- Students with **high SOL scores & low grades.**
- Students with **high SOL scores and poor attendance.**
- Capable students who could **benefit from a small pupil-to-teacher ratio and can work independently.**
- Capable students who can **increase their course load through a combination of distance & classroom learning.**
- Capable students who can **“recover failed credits” through distance learning.**
- Capable senior students who **could complete high school in one semester through classroom &/or distance learning.**
- Capable senior students who **need flexible schedules due to personal issues.**
