ACADEMIC GOOD STANDING

- To be in academic good standing, VLA students should have no more than two failing grades.
- Any student not in academic good standing will be deselected at the end of each marking period and returned to in-person instruction at their zone school.

MARKING PERIOD 2 CHECK-IN MEETINGS



Students in grades 6-12 should schedule a required Marking Period 2 check-in meeting with each of their teachers. These meetings may count for points in the course.

ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

Are you a synchronous student that did not attend a required Zoom?

Families must notify VVA teachers of an absence and let Point Option know by using the [Submit an Absence Link](#) on the Point Option website. This helps us keep accurate attendance records.

How is asynchronous attendance captured?

Asynchronous students must spend 1 hour of ACTIVE time in each course each day. Complete the checklist shared to the right to ensure your attendance is accurately marked.

DAILY CHECKLIST

Every school day virtual students should complete the below checklist for EACH of their classes:

- ✓ Read announcements.
- ✓ Go to your course calendar and see what is due for that day.
- ✓ Click on the "Grades" tab. Check for missing work or feedback.
- ✓ Watch the video for that day if asynchronous or attend the live session at the time on your schedule.
- ✓ Any remaining time should be spent going to modules and lessons, completing your assignments, & submitting work
- ✓ Remember to check your NNPS email for important info & updates on testing

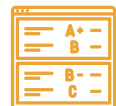
