COURSE REQUESTS SY25-26 UPDATES

High school students are registered as asynchronous. If you would like your student to be placed into a synchronous class for any of their courses, please complete this [Google Form \[linked\]](#). Virtual Virginia has limited synchronous options, so your timely response will impact the students placement in synchronous course.

MIDDLE SCHOOL ENROLLMENT UPDATE FOR SY25-26

All VLA middle school students will be enrolled in synchronous core classes with Virtual Virginia for the 2025-2026 school year. Completing work synchronously provides students will regular direct access to their virtual teacher. It also helps students establish good habits to be a strong virtual learner.

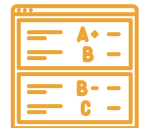
